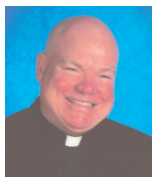

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord, to be followed on Friday, June 27, with the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The two feast are intimately linked. For example, some years ago we had a poster exhibition on Eucharistic miracles. One of them occurred at Lanciano, Italy, in the year 750, where the consecrated Host turned into Flesh and the consecrated wine into Blood. In 1971, the elements were scientifically analyzed and among other things, the miraculous Flesh was found to be "muscular striated tissue of the myocardium," in other words, from the heart muscle. It was also found to be truly living flesh and that if such flesh were extracted from a living human being, he would cease to live. Such miracles, although they belong to the realm of private revelation, do help to confirm the faith of believers. Jesus loves us from His Heart, so much so that He gives us Himself as our very Food. What our senses fail to fathom, let us grasp through faith's consent.

If you coach high school students, you are also required to complete fingerprinting. E-mail Deacon Bob at the address above and he will send directions. Neither St. Teresa nor any other archdiocesan location offers fingerprinting.
