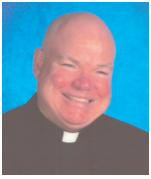

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The first petition at our Sunday Masses has been: *“Lord show me one way in this Mass I can become a better version of myself this week”*. When I heard that petition last Sunday, I thought of all the places I celebrated Mass while I was on sabbatical: in the communist countries of Laos and Vietnam; the totalitarian country of Burma which is on the UN list for the top ten in religious persecution; in the Kingdom of Cambodia where Buddhism is the state religion and which alone can broadcast its teaching; in Thailand at a WWII POW camp along the River Kwai. I also met with anti-Catholic prejudice aimed specifically at priests among my fellow travelers. Each Sunday as I wrote in my journal I realized the truth that I may be the only “Catholic Church” someone may meet that day. It also made me admire our fellow Catholics in those countries who preach and practice the Faith among so many difficulties and hardships. That is for me an added reason to pray for “Holy Mother Church” who is concerned about her children no matter what condition they find themselves, but especially those who suffer.
