If you volunteer at St. Antoninus and would like a pre-paid code to pay for the background check, **do not** start the background check when you register for VIRTUS. If you coach high school students, you are also required to complete fingerprinting. E-mail Deacon Bob at the address above and he will send directions. Neither St. Teresa nor any other archdiocesan location offers fingerprinting.
