Things I've Seen and Heard Musings of Fr. Bryan Reif

This past December, Bishop Joe Binzer contacted me about sharing with St. Antoninus parishioners the process that will be used to name a new pastor for St. Antoninus Parish. This is a process that would have taken place in 2015 at St. Antoninus because Fr. Armstrong's term as pastor was scheduled to end June 30, 2015. The Archdiocese of Cincinnati calls this the "open-listing process."

Priests of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati are notified by a group called the Priests' Personnel Board that a position is available. Priests throughout the nineteen counties of the Archdiocese will be notified in early February that the position of Pastor here at St. Antoninus, will be open-listed and available.

As part of the open-listing process, Bishop Binzer (in his capacity as the Priests' Personnel Director) will meet with the Parish Pastoral Council for their input about the pastoral needs and future goals of the Parish. That meeting will take place on January 26, 2015. Parish Pastoral Council members, parishioners, staff, priests and deacons may nominate any priest to serve as Pastor here. A priest may accept or decline the nomination. A nominee may consult with appropriate persons (including all priests and deacons with whom he would either live or work) about the assignment.

There may be more than one priest nominated to serve as the next Pastor here. The suitability of the applicants for the position will be the first consideration of the Priests' Personnel Board. Previous pastoral experience, the seniority of the applicants, continuing education and other efforts at updating will all be weighed in the deliberations of the Priests' Personnel Board. The Archbishop will hear the recommendation of this Board. A new Pastor of St. Antoninus should be named by May 15, 2015, even sooner, perhaps.

If you would like to nominate a priest to serve as Pastor of St. Antoninus Parish, please write to Bishop Binzer (Archdiocese of Cincinnati, 100 E 8th Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202) or e-mail him (jbinzer@catholiccincinnati.org). Most importantly, please pray for all involved in the process, and for the Parish. Please feel free to contact me or Bishop Binzer if you have any questions.

ALL EMPLOYEES AND REGULAR VOLUNTEERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ONE VIRTUS TRAINING MEETING. YOU MAY ATTEND HERE OR AT ANY OTHER LOCATION WITHIN THE ARCHDIOCESE. PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED AT: www.virtus.org. MAKE SURE THAT THE "USER'S LOCATION" YOU CHOOSE DURING REGISTRATION IS ST. ANTONINUS – EVEN IF YOU ATTEND VIRTUS AT ANOTHER LOCATION. If you volunteer at St. Antoninus and would like a pre-paid code to pay for the background check, do not start the background check when you register for VIRTUS. If you coach high school students, you are also required to complete fingerprinting. Kindly e-mail Deacon Bob at the address above and he will send directions.
