Things I've Seen and Heard Musings of Fr. Bryan Reif

I have a few odds and ends to tell you this week. On Wednesday January 14th, the Rectory had a new phone system installed which makes taking phone calls, and leaving voice messages, and retrieving those messages much easier for the staff, as well as for Fr. Mick and me. Of course there has been no change in the phone number, but there is now an automated system that answers the phone. When calling the Rectory, please be sure to follow the prompts to get to the correct extension.

It was brought to my attention recently that there are people parking in front of the church between the columns and under the roof overhang by the front doors of the church. I need to ask everyone, please, not to park under the overhang, or between the columns for two reasons: 1. If a column were to be accidentally bumped or hit by a car, it could potentially lead to a collapse of the roof overhang, since the columns hold up the roof, and 2. Other than for dropping off and picking up people, that space under the overhang needs to be kept clear in case an ambulance ever needed to be called to the church. Thank you for your understanding.

The parish will be installing equipment to the front doors of the church to make them automated doors. This was proposed by the Buildings and Grounds Committee. The purpose of automating the doors is to make our church more accessible to those with disabilities, which also serves to make the parish for all of us a more welcoming place to worship. The Building and Grounds Committee has asked me to ask all of you for a special donation to offset the cost of this necessary project. The total cost for the work is less than \$5000, and will help many of our parishioners have easier access to the church for Mass and prayer. Thank you for your consideration of our parish's needs.
